

One of the most important parts of the research process is to develop your research question. Without a question that is narrow enough without being too narrow you will find the research process daunting.


In order to prepare you for your project and your assignment next week, please take a few minutes to submit your research question. Remember that this is a draft. You will be refining the question in the next couple of weeks.
