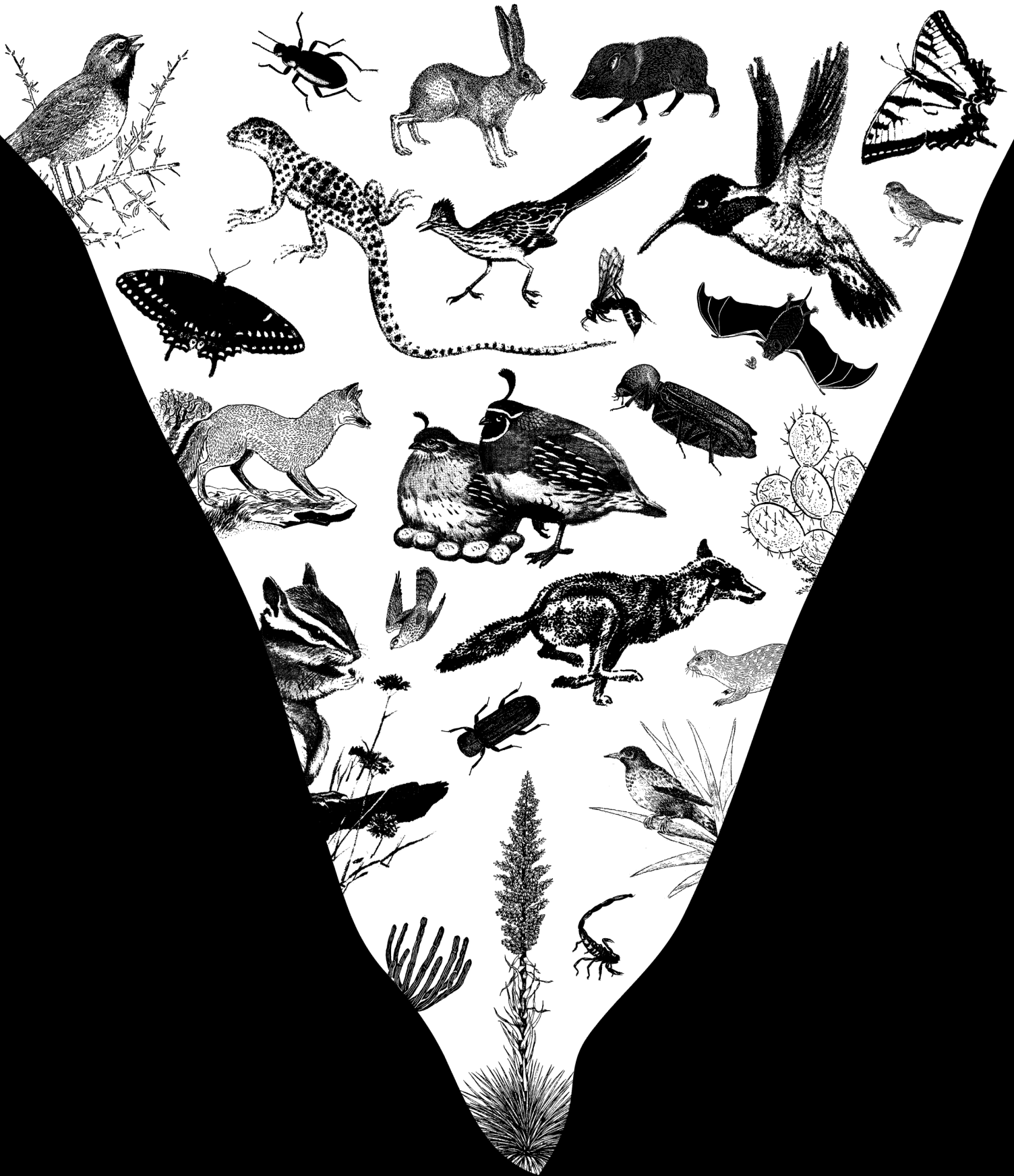


# SAVE EL PASO'S ARROYOS
