Her work on judicial redistricting, judicial diversity, and judicial representation on the bench has appeared in the *American Politics Quarterly*, the *Political Research Quarterly*, *Judicature*, the *Michigan Journal of Race & Law*, and the *Book of the States*. She is currently working on a book project focused on social identity and the law as well as conducting research on the criminalization of poverty, the relationship between law and social change, and the role of minority legal associations.
