

SEEKING SOLUTIONS

- The Provost's Office and the University Libraries of the University of Massachusetts Amherst launched the Open Education Initiative (OEI) in the Spring of 2011.
- The OEI is a faculty incentive program (a small grant) that encourages:
 - the creation of new teaching materials,
 - the use of library subscription materials,
 - or the use of existing open (free) information resources to support our students' learning.







The IAP program was initiated by The Metropolitan Museum of Art in 2007 to help address the challenges of scholarly publishing in the digital age by providing free images for academic publications through an automated Web-based service, IAP

is now available as an optional service to all museums who wish to foster scholarly publications. All IAP contributors also contribute images to the ARTstor Digital Library, which makes images available exclusively for teaching and educational use, not publication.

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
