

I visited Lazare Ervant Djinghenzian in his office at the Mines Branch in Ottawa when I was a Post-Doctoral Fellow there from 1960-62. He was born in Batom, Caucasus, went with his family to London in 1920, graduated as a mining engineer from the Royal School of Mines in London in 1924. He emigrated to Canada in 1926, where he worked in the mineral industry before joining the Mines Branch in 1948, becoming Chief of Mineral Processing Division in 1959. He wrote about the history of mineral processing in Canada.
