Irene Calboli is Professor of Law at Texas A&M University School of Law and a member of the Center for Law & Intellectual Property (CLIP). She also holds affiliated and honorary appointments in several leading universities, including Melbourne Law School, the School of Law of the University of Geneva, the Transatlantic Technology Law Forum at Stanford University, the University of Bologna, and the Royal University of Law and Economics in Phnom Penh (Cambodia). Irene teaches a variety of courses, including Intellectual Property Law, Fashion Law, International Trade law, and Comparative Law. She has a distinguished record of publications in academic and professional journals and is the author and editor of several leading books. She is a member of the editorial boards of the *Oxford Journal of Intellectual Property Law and Practice*, the *Queen Mary Journal of Intellectual Property*, the *WIPO-WTO Colloquium Papers*, and the *Trademark Reporter*, and the founder of the IP & Innovation Research of Asia Network, one of the most prominent scholarly associations in Asia, and the co-founder of the IP Researcher of Europe Conference. Irene is an elected member of the American Law Institute and serves in a variety of leadership roles in professional organizations. She is, inter alia, a past chair of the Art Law Section and the Chair-Elect of the East Asia Section of the Association of American Law Schools, the co-chair of the International Commercial Law Committee of the American Branch of the International Law Association (ILA), a member of the Council of the Singapore Branch of the ILA, and a member of the Committee of Global Cultural Heritage of the ILA (Headquarters).
