**August 2008 - Jan. 2010**      Compact Shelving Installation/Collection Shifting:  
Met with vendors, planned the different phases of the project with the Dean of the Law School and the Library Director. Asbestos abatement, shelving dismantling, platform and carpet installation, and finally building the actual compact shelving took place December 2008 – February 2009. Reshelving of journals and other materials then commenced. From May 2009 to the present, shifting of the entire lower level, followed by shifting of the entire second floor, has taken place. First floor shifting continues as time and help permit.

**August 2007 - Sept. 2009**      Electronic Rural Access Demonstration Project:  
The College of Law has asked the library to supervise a portion of the Electronic Rural Access Demonstration Project (ERADP). The grant-funded project has an organization component which will make available trial level courtroom activity and court proceedings from pre-selected remote sites to students at the College of Law. This taxonomy will be used and applied by law students who will regularly review and categorize the video that results from capturing these proceedings. I supervised an intern throughout the grant

over the course of several months. This grant has ended.

**July -  
August 2007**

Our Restatements of the Law were inventoried, and some were reclassified. Missing volumes, pocket parts and annual supplements will be replaced. We are classifying by subject rather than placing them together in a separate area.

**April 2006 -  
February 2008**

The "JX" call number reclassification project, consisting of international law and (mostly) international relations materials, has been completed.

This project, which involved over 6000 items, has resulted in re-numbering library shelving and a re-labeling project, as well as new library floor maps and updated website, to facilitate materials location for faculty, students and other patrons.

Created new statistics collection formats for Technical Services staff to gain better information for the ARL and ABA annual statistics.
