

TECHNONOGY PANEL BIOS

Oscar Macchioni - He was born in Tucumán, Argentina. Upon his graduation from the National University of Tucumán in 1991, he received a scholarship from the Polish Government to study piano in the city of Krakow. He received his Master in Music from Louisiana State University where he studied under the guidance of Michael Gurt. Currentl Mr. Macchioni is a doctoral candidate at The University of Arizona, Tucson, where he studies with Dr. Nohema Fernández.

He teaches music at the elementary and high school levels. Currently, Oscar is a Graduate Teaching Assistant of Class Piano at the University of Arizona and has a studio in the Tucson Area where he teaches piano and recorder incorporating technology in his lessons. Oscar Macchioni has performed extensively in his native Argentina, Poland, and in the USA, which has included such notable locations as Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall, Columbia University, Steinway Hall, and the Donnell Library in New York.
