

INFORMATION LITERACY REDEFINED


Information Literacy Competency Standards Framework for Information Literacy

"... a set of abilities requiring individuals to recognize when information is needed and have the ability to **locate**, **evaluate**, and **use** effectively the needed information."

"...the set of integrated abilities encompassing the **reflective** discovery of information, the understanding of how information is **produced** and **valued**, and the use of information in **creating** new **knowledge** and **participating** ethically in communities of learning."

- Authority is Constructed and Contextual
- Information Creation as a Process
- Information Has Value
- Research as Inquiry
- Scholarship as Conversation
- Searching as Strategic Exploration






American Culture 105 - History of Ethnic America






