- As an Associate Professor, I conduct research into areas related to the Kentucky Museum collections and associated research materials; give lectures to WKU classes; make the collection available to WKU faculty and students for use in hands-on learning projects; develop presentations for professional organizations and community groups; serve on departmental, college and university-wide committees and task forces; and participate in outside professional organizations.
